USVI Local Resource Disaster Guide — Summary & Purpose Prepared by North Tampa Housing Development Corporation (NTHDC)

The *USVI Local Resource Disaster Guide* was developed by NTHDC to help residents, community organizations, and stakeholders in the U.S. Virgin Islands (USVI) quickly access critical local resources during emergencies such as hurricanes, earthquakes, and other disasters.

This guide provides a clear overview of key agencies and organizations responsible for disaster preparedness, response, recovery, and coordination within the territory. It includes up-to-date contact information for:

- Virgin Islands Territorial Emergency Management Agency (VITEMA) primary coordinating body
- Office of the Governor executive leadership during emergencies
- Departments of Human Services & Health shelter, food, health, and mental health services
- Police, Fire, and EMS Departments public safety, rescue, and evacuation
- Water and Power Authority (WAPA) infrastructure restoration
- Community partners like the Red Cross, Community Foundations, and local VOADs

The guide also outlines coordination mechanisms such as the Emergency Operations Center (EOC), Multi-Agency Coordination (MAC) Group, and public information channels to ensure effective communication and resource sharing.

Purpose:

The guide's purpose is to empower stakeholders and community members with reliable, easy-to-access information to improve preparedness, support timely response efforts, and strengthen community resilience before, during, and after disasters.

In the **U.S. Virgin Islands (USVI)**, local disaster resource coordination involves several key agencies and organizations working together to prepare for, respond to, and recover from emergencies such as hurricanes, earthquakes, and other natural or man-made disasters.


Here are the primary local agencies and partners involved in disaster resource coordination:

Primary Local Agencies in USVI for Disaster Resource Coordination

1. Virgin Islands Territorial Emergency Management Agency (VITEMA): Central coordinating body for disaster preparedness, response, recovery, and mitigation.

Responsibilities:

- Develops the Territorial Emergency Operations Plan (TEOP)
- Activates and manages the Emergency Operations Center (EOC)
- Coordinates with FEMA and other federal agencies

2. Office of the Governor: Provides executive leadership and declares states of emergency when needed.
